7.1 Engineering Department

Under the guideline and direction of Vice Chancellor, the Executive Engineer, Deputy Engineer and Junior Engineers are working for construction as well as various works related to it and maintenance of buildings and roads at campus level and at sub-centres of the University. Shri J.D. Hadiyal is working as the Executive Engineer of Junagadh Agricultural University.

The main function of this department is water supply, maintenance of drainage system, street light, electrification, repairing of electrical faults, maintenance and repairs to the University office buildings, residential quarters, internal roads etc. The office of the Executive Engineer is also working as a custodian of the University properties. Besides this, the allotment of quarters to University employees/officers is also done by this office.
