



Chapter - VI

STUDENTS' WELFARE

6.1 Directorate of Students' Welfare

The Directorate of Students' Welfare, Junagadh Agricultural University is looking after various students' activities/ facilities including sports, culture, debate/essay, fellowships, scholarships, residential, recreation, health, adventure, NSS, Students' training, counselling and placement, etc. Moreover, dignitaries of different fields are invited to share their thoughts, experiences and views among the staff and students. Dr. P. V. Patel supervised and guided the students' welfare activities during the reporting year.

6.2 Students' Union

In the colleges of Junagadh Agricultural University, the Student Representative Council (SRC) is constituted by the principal of respective colleges by selecting the sincere and leading students in sports, culture, debate and adventure activities. The principal also nominates the Chairman and staff advisors and they act as a President of SRC of respective College.

6.3 Students' Facilities

All the undergraduate and post graduate students are provided hostel facilities with attached mess. Various hostel facilities exist for the students of different faculties, in addition to this, new hostels viz; New Nivedita (for girls), Vinayak (for PG), Vivekanand Hall of Residence (for Agri. Engg.) and Gokulesh hostel for Veterinary faculty also have been constructed. The new International hostel for foreign students constructed which was inaugurated

by Hon'ble Chancellor and H.E. the Governor of Gujarat on 4th February, 2012. A university library near the hostel area is utilized by students for reference, reading and net surfing. A sports complex also exists near the hostels and interested students utilize the facilities according to their choice. Two new play grounds for *Kabaddi* and *Kho-Kho* with covered shed are under preparation. Moreover, a multipurpose Indoor Sports Stadium constructed at the cost of ₹ 2.50 crore is on verge of completion and utilized once for organization the YES!+ workshop a mega event for the students in the history of the University.

Students' Counselling and Placement

Director of Students' Welfare coordinates and monitors the activities of Student Counselling and Placement cells functioning in all the constituent colleges of the Junagadh Agricultural University.

The objectives of Student Counselling and Placement cell functioning under the Director, Students' Welfare is to maintain data base of the students of outgoing batch and to keep in constant touch with various employers for conducting campus interview for providing better placement. The Directorate also arranged special lectures and short term training on Personality Development and life skills for the students of all the faculties, so as to, built the self esteem among the students and to face the challenges with confidence.

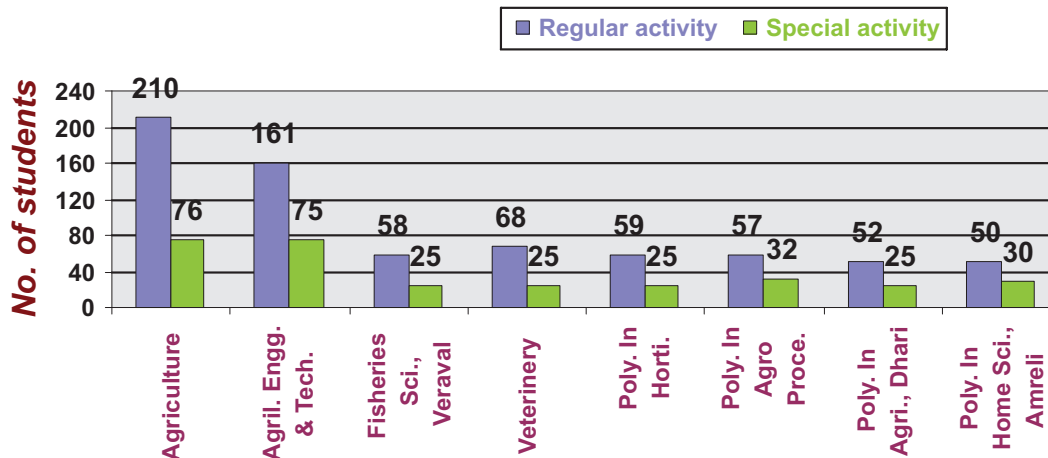
